Mention "Caravan" to almost any theatre performer in British Columbia and you'll be met with a smile as memories of a magical place of creativity and community come rushing in. In **The Originals**, award-winning artist and director Niall McNeil ventures back to where he grew up—the 80 acres outside of Armstrong, BC on unceded Secwépemc and Syilx territory that is home to Caravan Farm Theatre, a legendary outdoor theatre company established in 1978. The film explores the history of Caravan Farm Theatre, Niall's own roots as an artist, as well as the founders of the Caravan Stage Company.

This documentary film is presented with audio description, courtesy of Niall McNeil and **The Originals**. Running time is approximately 45 minutes.

Host Amy Amantea will be joined by special guests Niall McNeil and Joan McNeil for conversation and community Q and A.

About Niall McNeil, Filmmaker

Niall's creative accomplishments are many and include performing with <u>Caravan Farm Theatre</u> in the Okanagan, Vancouver's <u>Leaky Heaven</u> and <u>Neworld Theatre</u>, and in Ottawa with the English Acting Company of the <u>National Arts Centre</u>. With his collaborators, he's written and published a number of plays, including **Peter Panties** and **King Arthur's Night**, and in 2022 Niall became the first artist with Down syndrome to be awarded a Canada Council for the Arts Composite Grant to support the development of three new multidisciplinary works.

Almost Live events are designed to be accessible for people who are blind and partially sighted.
